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BLUE VALLEY RECREATION COMMISSION

The educational and recreational programs offered by the Blue Valley Recreation Commission are supported by user fees. Participants in the programs are required to pay user fees for each program for which they register. Blue Valley residents with low incomes may qualify for scholarship funds to cover some of those fees. Scholarship credits are available to youth participants, eighteen (18) and younger.

The Commission is solely responsible for determining the eligibility of an applicant. That determination is based on financial documentation and information provided by the applicant on the Scholarship Application form and will be valid for the program year. The BVRC program year runs from August 1st to July 31st. Applications received after January 31st will be limited to one-half of the standard scholarship award.

Scholarships will be awarded based on annual level of income, with the approved applicant paying 50% of the program fee for most recreational programs or classes, up to \$500 per year. Scholarship credits may not be used for private lessons and are non-transferable. If a class or program is offered by the BVRC at multiple locations, on various days, and/or at several times, the Commission reserves the right to enroll scholarship participants in the class or program of the Commission's choice.

*The initial scholarship application must be submitted at least ten business days prior to registering for a class or program. Applicants will be notified in writing as to the decision by the BVRC to award scholarship credits. All registrations must be accompanied by the scholarship award letter.

In an effort to afford scholarship recipients the same registration opportunity that is open to all patrons, they may register on-line for classes. It will be necessary, however, to pay for the classes by credit card at the time of the on-line registration. After registering on-line, please bring a copy of the registration confirmation and your scholarship award letter, to the staff at either the Activity Center or the Recreation Complex. Registration staff at either location will be able to process a credit toward the card used to pay for the class or program fees. **Please note: to ensure a refund for registering on-line, the scholarship application must have been submitted, reviewed and scholarship credits awarded, prior to registering on-line with a credit card.**
