RULES

- Rosters must be submitted before the start of your second game. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of any game in question. Manager will have the option of challenging rosters until the completion of the fourth inning. A player may not play on two teams in the same division. Players may be added to team rosters throughout pool play. However the roster on file at the beginning of a game is the official roster for that game. Rosters are "frozen" once their final pool play game has begun.
- Each team will hit their own **YELLOW** ASA approved softballs (.44cor /375 lbs comp.)
- All men's teams must start and finish with 9 players. The open batting position will not be declared an out unless as a result of an ejection.
- Coed teams must start and finish with minimum of 8 and have the same number of men and women at all times.
- ASA rules regarding coed player positioning will not be used.
- All games, except the championship game, will have a 55 minute time limit.
- A 10-minute grace period will be given to teams for their first game only. Time consumed by the grace period comes off game length.
- The batter will enter the batters box with a count of 1&1. One foul ball will be allowed after two strikes before invoking the appropriate rules for third strike.
- Run spread rules will apply: 15-run after three innings, 12-run after four innings, 10-run after five innings.
- The "International Tie-Breaker" will be used in all games except the championship game.
- Coed only: if the male walks, he will be awarded 2nd base and the female will be required to bat, except when there are two outs and then she will have the option to walk or bat.
- Courtesy runners will be allowed in the event of an injury only.
- Home run rule: Men's "D" - 1, Coed - 1.
- Games will be played using the One Up Rule. Under this rule either team may hit additional home runs to go one-up on their opponent. However, if time has expired or the game has reached the bottom of the 7th or extra innings, the HOME team may not go one-up. Any home run exceeding these restrictions will result in the batter being called out.

In all other situations A.S.A. rules will be used.
