At this point in the schedule, there is one game left to be played within the regular season. Because another complete round cannot be played, each team will be given a new team number, "R", based on league standings as of July 7. In the case of a tie in the standings to determine the "R" number, the following criteria will be used: 1) head to head competition, 2) fewest runs allowed versus the team(s) tied with, 3) flip of a coin. For example, if a team is in third place going into the July 9 games, the team will now be 3R for the remainder of the season. These ranking games are still part of the regular season.
