Every head coach in a BVRC youth sports program must be certified in the National Youth Sports Coaches Association program.

The National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA) is a nation-wide youth sports coaches training program that involves videotape presentations from youth sports experts, in-depth discussions between the clinician/participants and various handouts. The NYSCA program's primary objective is to ensure that youth sports are a fun, positive, learning experience for children.

There are two main parts to the NYSCA program – the first year and then succeeding years.

Year One

“Introduction to Coaching Youth Sports” Classes

- Coaches who have never attended a NYSCA clinic need to attend 2 classes (a class #1 and a class #2 – see reverse side) in order to become a certified coach.
- Coaches who are certified in another sport, i.e., baseball, must attend a class #2 in order to become a certified coach in baseball/softball.
- There is no fee to the coach for attending these classes.

Succeeding Years

Continuing Education Program

- After completing the two “Introduction To Coaching Youth Sports” classes, coaches automatically qualify for the Certified Coach Continuing Education Program and further classes are not required.
- Coaches will receive, from the NYSCA headquarters, an invitation to the Certified Coach Continuing Education Program prior to your membership expiration date. You, the coach, may then sign the Coaches Code of Ethics Pledge and submit the annual dues of \$20. However, continuing with the program is not a BVRC requirement.
